Profile: His Excellency Dr. Radu - Petru ȘERBAN

He took up his appointment as Ambassador to Japan in 2012.

He served in the Ministry of Economy and Commerce (MEC), 1975 – 1989, including posting at Romanian embassies in Hungary, Poland, Sweden and Brussels where he was Minister Counselor for economic affairs at the Romanian Mission to the European Union. He joined the Ministry for Foreign Affairs in 2002. He served as Director General for Economic Diplomacy 2003 – 2007, Deputy Chief of Mission, Romanian Embassy to Belgium 2007 – 2009, Director for Economic Relations 2009 – 2012, and Minister Plenipotentiary, Embassy of Romania, London, 1990 – 2002.

He graduated in 1975 from the Academy of Economic Studies, Faculty of International Economic Relations, Bucharest, and earned in 2000 a Doctorate in Economy, on “European Economic Integration” at the Academy of Economic Studies, Bucharest. He has published articles and books on economy, trade and European integration.
